

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

### **2010 NASH COUNTY TAX LISTING**

All taxable personal property and all changes made to real estate must be listed for taxation during the month of January. Taxable personal property includes mobile homes, unlicensed motor vehicles, farm equipment, business/personal property, airplanes, boats, jet skis and dogs. Real estate only, does not have to be listed.

Listing forms will be mailed only to those who listed personal property in 2009. If you did not list taxable property in 2009 and you now own taxable personal property, you may call (252) 459-9816 and a form will be mailed to you. All listings by mail must be postmarked (not metered) no later than January 31, 2010.

Assistance in listing is available at the Nash County Tax Office in the Claude Mayo Administration Building, 120 W Washington Street, Nashville, Monday through Friday 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. during the month of January. Any questions concerning listing should be directed to (252) 459-9816.

**LIST IN JANUARY. LATE LISTING PENALTIES WILL BE IMPOSED AS REQUIRED BY LAW.**

Applications for the following exemptions must be filed no later than June 1, 2010.

ELDERLY AND PERMANENTLY DISABLED  
EXEMPTION, DISABLED VETERANS EXEMPTION,  
CIRCUIT BREAKER EXEMPTION.

To request an application for one these programs please call (252) 459-1222. Applications are also available in the listing and collections departments of the Nash County Tax Office.

Applications for all other exemptions including, but not limited to Farm Use and the Builder's Deferral should be made during the month of January.
